Christmas Day 2017

Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all May you have perfect peace as you trust/believe in him. May the power of the Holy Spirit fill you with hope.

Jesus is God of Hope - **John 8:58** "What I'm about to tell you is true," Jesus answered. "Before Abraham was born, I am!"

Jesus said in **John 10:30** that He was one with the Father.

John 1:3 tells us, Everything came into existence through *him*. Not one thing that exists was *made without him*. Jesus was there at the beginning of time.

Col 1:15-18 We look at this Son and see the God who cannot be seen. We look at this Son and see God's original purpose in everything created. He planned to create one new people out of Jews and Gentiles. He wanted to make peace between them. 16 He planned to bring both Jews and Gentiles back to God as one body. He planned to do this through the cross. **On that cross, Christ put to death their hatred toward one another.** 17 He came and preached peace to you who were far away. He also preached peace to those

who were near. 18 Through Christ we both come to the Father by the power of one Holy Spirit.)

There are many barriers that divide us today, age, appearance, intelligence, political views, economic status, race, religion, colour, even theological differences which are stifling the love of Jesus Christ... but thank God for Jesus, who came and knocked down these barriers to unify all believers in Himself through the cross.

When a person encounters the cross of Jesus all barriers are broken - Hallelujah! That is why you see many Christian organisations working in war torn countries helping and assisting those in need - because of the cross.

Palestine and Israel must come to the cross of Jesus for genuine peace. Your peace can only come from Jesus and no one else through the cross.

Have we come to that cross of Jesus and laid down our lives with burdens and problems? Have we asked Jesus this amazing King of all Kings and Lord of all Lords into our lives? Are we walking daily with Jesus through the Holy Spirit? **2Cor 1:22** it is He who has also put His seal on us [that is, He has appropriated us and certified us as His] and has given us the [Holy] Spirit in our hearts as a pledge [like a security deposit to guarantee the fulfillment of His promise of eternal life]

So we who have chosen to know and follow him, find hope in him. We are sure that his life, death, and resurrection have changed everything. You don't have to believe this. He won't make you. He won't bruise you or force you or coerce you. That isn't his way. But he does invite you. He does welcome you home to hope.

The choice is entirely yours. It is Christ, or it is chaos. I'm placing my faith in Jesus. And I'm absolutely sure he is the hope that you and I need!
