Pursuing Jesus

Why must we pursue Jesus or follow Jesus passionately?

Because Jesus pursued us and came for us first in our sinful state. The reason Jesus came to this earth and lived as a man is because He loved us so much. When you love someone you pursue them.. right?

The Bible tells us in <u>Romans 5:6-8</u> Christ arrives right on time to make this happen. He didn't, and doesn't, wait for us to get ready. He presented himself for this sacrificial death when we were far too weak and rebellious to do anything to get ourselves ready. And even if we hadn't been so weak, we wouldn't have known what to do anyway. We can understand someone dying for a person worth dying for, and we can understand how someone good and noble could inspire us to selfless sacrifice. But God put his love on the line for us by offering his Son in sacrificial death while we were of no use whatever to him.

Jesus put his love on the line for us by giving his life for us - this is love that pursues us where Jesus loved us first So why must we pursue Jesus passionately?

Jesus came to make us righteous through him. Jesus knew that our righteousness was filthy and any attempt made to become right with God was futile because of sin that came through Adam. So God had a plan of restoration through Jesus Christ whom God sent for us that through His blood we might be reconciled to God or brought back to relationship with God.

<u>Rom 5: 17</u> For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the **gift** of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ!

Righteousness is to be made right with God, to be in a place where sin or the guilt of sin has no bearing on our lives. when we live in righteousness it is as if we had never sinned. This is what's amazing about being made righteous in Jesus Christ. No more condemnation. The devil has no power to condemn you and accuse you of sin! Hallelujah! Isn't this worth pursuing Jesus for?

Because Jesus loves us deeply - It is His love that compelled Him to come. It is love that compels you to follow someone. It is the unconditional love of Jesus that pursues us daily that even when we fail and fall and mess up at times his love never lets go. Even when we at times due to our ignorance and failures let go of Jesus, He never lets go of us. His love for us is constant.

When the nation of Israel were exiled to Babylon for 70 years by King Nebuchadnezzar because of their rebellion, Despite that God gives them a word through Jeremiah the prophet saying He will visit them and perform his good word toward them (Jer 29:10) and we all know vs 11 where God says He knows the thoughts he thinks towards us, thoughts of peace to give us a future and a hope... and He says when you call on Me and pray to Me I will listen.

Then in Jeremiah 31: 3-4 God says this: The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness. 4 I will build you up again, and you, Virgin Israel, will be rebuilt.
